Situation Summary

<u>BART</u> will close the tracks between Daly City and Glen Park stations during seven (7) weekends between the end of July and October 2016 to perform critical track safety repairs and upgrades which will reduce track noise and also make improvements at the Balboa Park Station.

During each of these weekends, trains will stop running at the close of service Friday and resume service at 4:00 AM on Monday. **The Balboa Park Station will be closed for each of these seven weekends**. Also, during each of these weekends, some delay is expected.

Free bus shuttle services will take passengers between Daly City and Glen Park stations. Please see the <u>last page</u> for details. Riders should expect 20- 40 minute delays – plan accordingly.

Passengers travelling to SFO and Millbrae should plan to add an extra hour to travel time.

Please note that the **Labor Day Weekend** closure will begin at the close of service on Friday, September 2nd and resume service at 4:00 AM on Tuesday, September 6th.


Important BART Service Notices

During the seven weekends of closures, some lines will have limited BART Service:

- Richmond (Red Line) train service will end at Montgomery Station. You must transfer to Yellow Line or Blue Line to continue on to either Glen Park or 24th Street Stations (respectively). Red Line service will resume between Daly City and Millbrae Stations. There will be no Red Line service on Sundays between Richmond and Montgomery Stations.
- Pittsburg/Bay Point (Yellow Line) train service will end at Glen Park Station. You must take a shuttle bus to continue on to Daly City Station. Yellow Line service will resume between Daly City and SFO Stations.
- **Dublin (Blue Line) train service will end at 24**th **Street Station.** You must transfer to Yellow Line to continue on to Glen Park where you will need to take a shuttle bus to continue on to Daly City Station. Service **will** be available between Daly City and SFO Stations.

Bus Shuttle Services

BART will have ambassadors and signs at the stations to assist customers. <u>SamTrans</u> will provide free express shuttle buses between Daly City and Glen Park stations. These bus rides will be approximately 15- 20 minutes in length. Please expect delays of 20- 40 minutes.

Passengers travelling to SFO and Millbrae should add an extra hour to their travel time.

Additionally, <u>SFMTA</u> will provide a free local shuttle for the three stations: Glen Park, Balboa Park, and Daly City. This local service trip should take 10 minutes between Glen Park and Balboa Park station and 15 minutes between Balboa Park and Daly City Station. SFMTA (MUNI) Shuttle Boarding Locations

- Glen Park Station: Diamond at Bosworth Street (23-Monterey Stop)
- Balboa Park Station: Geneva Avenue in front of the station, between I-280 and San Jose Avenue (8-Bayshore, 43-Masonic, 54-Felton Stops)
- Daly City Station: Station Bus Loop (28-19th Avenue, 54-Felton, and 14R-Mission Rapid Stops)

Alternative Transit Options

The following transit agencies have service available to connect riders to these impacted BART stations during the weekend closure. Please click on the links for each agency to learn about routes.

- <u>SFMTA</u>- Regular paid service is available from the following SFMTA lines: the J-Church line, 14R-Mission Rapid line, 14-Mission line, and the 49-Mission-Van Ness line
- <u>Caltrain</u>- For passengers travelling to/from Millbrae BART Station or anywhere else in the Peninsula.
- <u>SamTrans</u>- For passengers travelling in the Peninsula.
