BART Weekend Track Closure Between Daly City and Glen Park Stations Saturday, September 3rd- Monday, September 5th, 2016

As a reminder, **BART** will be closing the tracks between Daly City and Glen Park Stations Labor Day Weekend, Saturday, September 3rd through Monday, September 5th. Service between these stations stops at the close of service Friday and resumes at 4 AM on Tuesday. Free bus shuttles provided by <u>SFMTA</u> and <u>SamTrans</u> will take passengers in between stations.
