BART Service Update As of March 23rd, 2016

The information below in italics was received directly from BART regarding the service between Pittsburgh/Bay Point & North Concord. This information is current as of March 23rd, 2016 @ 4PM.

LATEST UPDATE FROM BART 3/23/2016 4 PM

BART is running shuttle trains between North Concord and Bay Point stations every 10-minutes. Passengers with a final destination of Bay Point must transfer at North Concord. Passengers departing from Bay Point must transfer at North Concord for a SFO/San Francisco train.

NO SAFETY CONCERN FOR RIDERS

There's no safety risk or concern for riders on the shuttle trains going over the area that is being assessed for voltage spikes, because the voltage spikes may not even be noticeable to them.

"Crews are looking over the data collected from sophisticated measurement tools equipped over the weekend," said Alicia Trost, BART spokeswoman. "Experts are assisting in this process. The root cause of the spike in voltage has not yet been discovered."

REPAIRING DAMAGED CARS

While one team focuses on finding and fixing the electrical problems, technicians in BART shops are working round the clock to repair the damaged cars as quickly as safely possible.

"The car count has improved" as crews repair more and more cars, she said.

Crews on Wednesday continued their work of repairing the 50 or so train cars that had been damaged by the voltage spikes.

"We are also exploring alternate suppliers of the parts we need," Trost said. "We are cautiously optimistic that the car availability will be on an upward trajectory toward improvement."

A new Fleet of the Future is on the way to bring some relief to crowded cars (more info at www.bart.gov/cars), however, other infrastructure needs such as replacing old rails, updating train control equipment, expanding maintenance facilities and rebuilding other parts of the system must be dealt with as well.

BART Weekend Track Closures San Leandro and Bay Fair Stations

--Intermittent Weekends from March 26th- June 12th, 2016--

We have received the following information from BART regarding their **upcoming weekend track closures between San Leandro and Bay Fair Stations**:

As part of maintenance for the "Building a Better BART" program, there will be no BART train service between San Leandro and Bay Fair stations on selected weekends between March and June as BART crews perform vital repairs to the equipment and tracks.

BART will have a **bus bridge** between San Leandro and Bay Fair Stations provided by AC Transit. The bus bridge will cause 30 minute to 1 hour delays for some customers. Customers traveling between Fremont to Richmond will have to transfer to the bus bridge at Bay Fair, back to a train at San Leandro, and then transfer to a Richmond-bound train.

There will be extra staff in our stations to assist you. Give yourself extra travel time, follow signs, and listen to announcements for important information.

Travel tips

- Consider using a station not affected by the bus bridge if you are able.
- ➤ Lock your bike at our stations rather than bringing them on crowded buses.


