San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) has provided new maps to detail the areas impacted by Super Bowl City and the NFL Experience. Super Bowl City and NFL Experience activities begin on January 30 and end at 3:00 PM on Super Bowl Sunday (2/7).

Super Bowl City (Justin Herman Plaza) activities are open to the public and are offered free of charge. For

SFMTA will be issuing a number of parking credentials to garage/property managers that will allow monthly parkers to access buildings within the footprints of Super Bowl City and NFL Experience. TMA SF Connects members have been given an opportunity to **complete a survey** to document their needs for parking passes. Surveys must be completed by **January 15th, close of business**.

Final details about the parking credentialing program are being discussed. As of this writing, the credentials are being issued for monthly parkers. "Transient" parking issues are being analyzed. Deliveries are expected to continue as usual, with delays anticipated.

Earlier this week, TMA SF Connects hosted a Super Bowl 50 Forum. Panelists included BART Police, Operations, Station and Customer Service management. Among the recommendations for maximizing BART resources during the Super Bowl 50 festivities was information to encourage commuters to be flexible in scheduling their trips to work.

In general before 7:30 AM and after 9:30 AM will provide the least crowding on trains bound for San Francisco. Leaving the City in the afternoon is most effective before 4:30 PM and after 6:30 PM for commuters hoping to avoid the largest crowds.
