Overview

The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) and the SuperBowl Host Committee have recently revealed the **transportation plan** for the Super Bowl 50.

The plan has the safety of the public in mind, including those who live and work in San Francisco and need to get to where they're going with minimal disruptions.

During the week leading up to the Super Bowl, many activities will be held in downtown San Francisco, including **Super Bowl City**, a fan village on Market Street that will be open to the public, and the **NFL Experience**, an interactive professional football-themed park at the Moscone Center.

- All Muni lines will operate except E-line
- Some bus lines that run downtown will be rerouted to nearby streets.
- Autos and parking downtown will be limited to accommodate transit routes and emergency vehicles.
- There will be increased service on Muni metro.
- Commuters are **encouraged to use public transportation** during this time, since driving downtown will be difficult.
- Specific transit and traffic reroute information will be available in January.
