





SF Muni Service Delays on Market Wednesday, July 20th, 2016

We just received notice from <u>511</u> and <u>SFMTA</u> of a protest march near Market and 6th Street disrupting Muni service and causing delays. According to <u>SFGate</u>, this march is being held by Service Employee International Union members. Market Street bus service has been rerouted to Mission Street. SFMTA has identified these <u>alternatives</u> to get around during SF Muni service disruptions.

At this time, it is unclear where and when this protest will end. Conditions are subject to change and we encourage you to check with local transportation and media services for more information.
