Critical Mass Friday, December 30th, 2016 @ 5:30 PM Justin Herman Plaza

On the last Friday of each month San Francisco is host to the Critical Mass bicycle ride. The ride will begin at **5:30 PM** on **Friday**, **December 30th**, **2016** at **Justin Herman Plaza**, and then continue on a spontaneously-determined route.

Please use caution while driving near bicyclists. Allow extra time if you plan to travel to and from downtown; there will be heavy traffic on downtown streets. SFMTA/ Muni Fare Changes

Information Provided by SFMTA, Effective January 1st, 2017

Starting January 1st, 2017, single-trip Muni fares paid with a Clipper Card or the MuniMobile app will cost 25 cents less than **on-board cash fares and Limited Use Tickets purchased at Muni Metro stations, which will cost \$2.50 (effective 1/1/17).** For discounted fares, including youth, seniors, an dpeople with disabilities, that cash/limited use ticket will cost \$1.25.

Additionally, the Adult Monthly "A" Pass (Muni + BART within San Francisco) will have a \$5 price increase and will cost \$91.00 starting January 1, 2017. The discount monthly pass (Muni Only) will be raised from \$25.00 to \$36.00.

Vallejo Ferry Service/RT 200 Discontinued

Information Provided by <u>SF Bay Ferry</u>, Effective January 2nd, 2017

Beginning January 2, WETA will implement a new schedule that increases the number of weekday ferry departures and permanently discontinues all Route 200 bus service. Weekday ferry schedule additions include four new departures from Vallejo and three new departures from San Francisco. In addition, the existing 8:00 AM weekday Vallejo departure will be discontinued. While all scheduled Route 200 bus service (weekday and weekend) will be discontinued, bus service through Soltrans Route 80 will still be available providing a connection to BART's El Cerrito Del Norte station. The weekday ferry schedule in effect beginning January 2 is below. There will be no changes to the current weekend ferry schedule.

Golden Gate Transit Schedule Changes

Effective December 11th, 2016

Golden Gate Transit adjusted bus schedules in order to improve system efficiency. Routes 2, 4, 8, 18, 24, 24X, 27, 30, 38, 54, 56, 58, 70, 72, 72X, 74, 76, 92, 93, and 101 are affected. For new timetables, visit <u>Golden Gate Transit</u>.

Key Points: (*Information Provided by Golden Gate Transit)

- **Route 27** Mid-day trips now serve all bus pads from Spencer Ave Bus Pad to Lucky Drive Bus Pad. <u>*Click for new timetables*</u>
- Route 40X Now operates express service (bypasses stops) from Richmond (Cutting Blvd & Harbor Way) to San Rafael (Bellam Blvd). Three trips are added in each direction. <u>Click for</u> <u>new timetables</u>
- Route 44 Schedule adjustments. <u>*Click for new timetables*</u>
- **Route 93** Last southbound trip (departing Toll Plaza at 8:45 am) cancelled. <u>*Click for new timetables*</u>
- **Route 101** Southbound weekday trip at 6:02 am now leaves at 6:22 am and arrives at SFCC at 8:20 am. Other schedule adjustments. *Click for new timetables*
