



SFSU Commencement at AT&T Park

Thursday, May 25th, 2017

We have received the following notice from <u>SFMTA</u> regarding the San Francisco State University Commencement at AT&T Park this evening from 6:30 PM to 9:30 PM:

Thursday, May 25: San Francisco State University's 2017 Commencement will be held at AT&T Park. The ceremony will begin at around 6:30 p.m. and conclude with fireworks at around 9:30 p.m. Gates will open at 3 p.m. An attendance of 35,000 is expected.

Motorists are advised to avoid the increased congestion in downtown San Francisco and to avoid using the Bay Bridge in the two hours before and after the ceremony. Use of public transit, taxi, bicycles or walking is recommended.

Heavy traffic is expected in and around AT&T Park. Those who choose to drive should allow extra travel time.

A street closure of Terry Francois between 3rd and South streets will be required from 3 to 10 p.m.
