### Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup>- Sunday, May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019

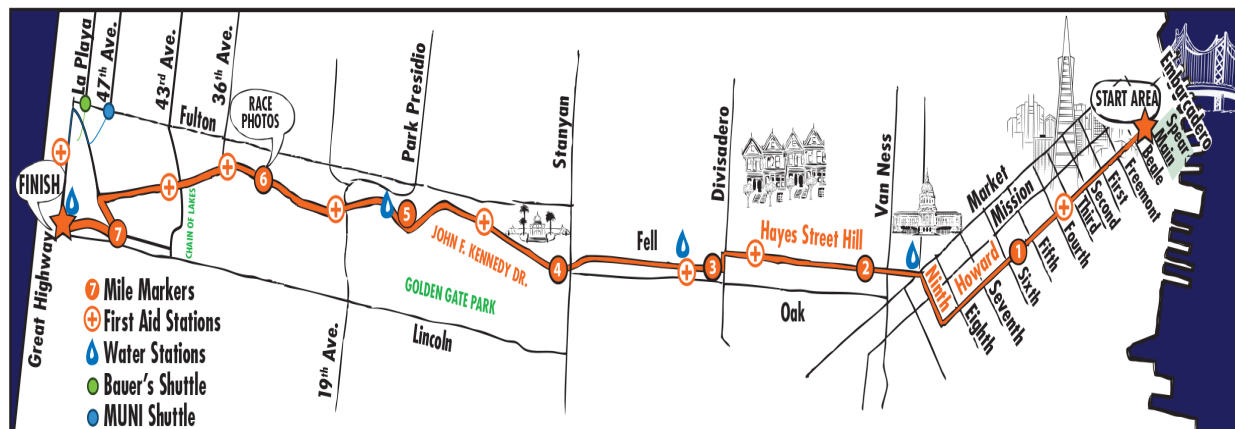

### Bay to Breakers Race

#### Sunday, May 19<sup>th</sup> | Embarcadero to Great Highway

The 107<sup>th</sup> Annual *Bay to Breakers* 12k race will be held on Sunday, May 19<sup>th</sup> starting at 8:00 AM. The 12k race starts near the San Francisco Bay at Howard and Main and runs west through the city and finishes at the Great Highway. The Alaska Airlines *Bay to Breakers* Finish Line Festival will commence as runners cross the finish line alongside Ocean Beach following the race. ### SFMTA/MUNI

[MuniMobile](#), the official SFMTA mobile ticketing app, is the easiest way to purchase your tickets for any Muni service before and after the race. SFMTA/Muni passes are also available at the Orig3n Health & Wellness Expo on May 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. Passes are valid all day on race day on Muni services (excluding Cable Car). **The race will impact Muni service all day Sunday (5/19). Please refer to [SFMTA](#) for more details.**

### BART – Early Opening and Extra Trains

The BART system will open early with service starting at 6:00 AM on Sunday. Trains running before 8:00 AM will run at 20 to 30-minute intervals. [Click here](#) for more information.

### Caltrain – Extra Trains

Caltrain will have four extra pre-race trains to San Francisco and one additional local train after the race from San Francisco to San Jose. [Click here for the special service schedule](#). One-way and Day Pass tickets to the Alaska Airlines *Bay to Breakers* will go on sale starting May 13<sup>th</sup> at any station ticket machine.

### Golden Gate Larkspur Ferry – Added Service

### San Francisco Bay Ferry – Special Vallejo Service

The San Francisco Bay Ferry will add special morning service departing from Vallejo at 6:00 AM and arriving at the San Francisco Ferry Building at 7:00 AM on Sunday, May 19<sup>th</sup>. [Click here](#) for details.
