Fare Changes in Effect July 1st, 2019

SFMTA/Muni, Golden Gate Transit, Golden Gate Ferry, Golden Gate Bridge Tolls, and San Francisco Bay Ferry all have fare changes in effect July 1st, 2019. Please see below for more details.

SFMTA/Muni Fare Changes

- Reduced Fare Single Rides, including youth, seniors, people with disabilities and Medicare recipients.
- Fare increase for Single Ride.
- Single-trip fares paid with the MuniMobile® ticketing app or a Clipper Card will cost 50 cents less than onboard cash fares and Limited Use Tickets.
- Fare increases for monthly “A” and “M” passes for unlimited travel for Muni and BART within San Francisco and discounted monthly passes for Senior, Youth and People with Disabilities not participating in the Free Muni programs.

Golden Gate Transit Bus and Golden Gate Ferry Regional Fare Increase

As part of a five-year fare program, Golden Gate Transit Bus (GGT) and Golden Gate Ferry (GGF) regional fares will increase on Monday, July 1st, 2019. Discount fare programs will remain in effect for Clipper users, seniors, youth, and persons with disabilities. Golden Gate Bridge Tolls Increase

On Monday, July 1st, 2019, all Golden Gate Bridge toll rates will increase. This includes the FasTrak Account rate (from \$7.00 to \$7.35), the Pay-As-You-Go rate (includes License Plate Accounts and One-Time Payments, from \$8.00 to \$8.20), Toll Invoice rate (from \$8.00 to \$8.35), carpool rate (from \$5.00 to \$5.35), and multi-axle vehicle toll rates. San Francisco Bay Ferry

On July 1st, 2019, the Water Emergency Transportation Authority (WETA) will increase base level adult fares by approximately 3%. This is the fifth and last of five annual fare increases in accordance with the FY2015-2020 Fare Program adopted by the WETA Board of Directors in September 2014. The Fare Program is intended to offset inflationary cost increases and rising operational costs.
