BART Weekend Track Closure between Orinda and Walnut Creek

Saturday, August 31st- Monday, September 2nd

[BART](#) will close the tracks between Orinda and Walnut Creek stations from August 31st through September 2nd to allow for major track replacement work. In addition, the two left eastbound lanes on Highway 24 in Lafayette near Oak Hill Road will be closed starting at 11:00 PM on Friday, August 30th with both lanes scheduled to be reopened by 7:00 AM on Tuesday, September 3rd. Track shutdowns between Orinda and Walnut Creek stations will also happen on the following weekends: 9/14 - 9/15, 9/28- 9/29, 10/12- 10/13, and 10/26- 10/27.

Every track shutdown weekend will include free bus service provided by County Connection and AC Transit between the Orinda, Lafayette, and Walnut Creek stations. BART riders can expect delays of 40 minutes or more during the track shutdown weekends.

In addition, single tracking will take place between Orinda and Walnut Creek on the following Saturdays: September 7th, September 21st, and October 19th. Riders can expect delays of up to 30 minutes on single-tracking days. Please [click here](#) for more information.
