

## Paycheck Protection Program Application Information

TMASF Connects is providing this information to help members navigate the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP). As of this email, this is SBA's <u>current application</u>. We decided to walk through the process of how to fill out the form without applying and found that this is a fairly straight forward process. Please share this information with your tenants.

In order for you to apply, you should first consult with your <u>local lender</u> or through any federally insured depository institution, federally insured credit union as to whether they are participating in the program. Secondly if they are participating, they will provide you all the necessary forms that need to be submitted with your PPP application. The funds allocated to this program is **extremely competitive and time sensitive** so please do not hesitate if you plan on applying.
