

## **Muni Metro Service Temporarily Suspended and Spare the Air Alerts**

According to [SF Gate](#), beginning today, Tuesday, August 25<sup>th</sup>, Muni Metro service has once again been suspended due to failures in the overhead wiring and an employee in the system's control center testing positive for COVID-19. Train service is estimated to be suspended for several weeks.

[Spare the Air Alerts](#) have also been issued until Friday, August 28<sup>th</sup> in the San Francisco Bay Area. Concentrations of ozone pollution are forecast to be unhealthy.
