

COVID-19 Vaccination Information and Map Updated February 25th, 2021

We would like to inform you that SF Gate has created a <u>map</u> of vaccination sites in the SF Bay Area, with information sourced from <u>VaccinateCA</u>, a community-driven effort to track vaccine availability. <u>SF Chronicle</u> also has information on where to get vaccines.

BART

As of Tuesday, February 16th, BART is providing free BART rides home (valued at \$7) for those being vaccinated at the Oakland Coliseum site. Please show your vaccination card with a matching date to BART staff at the Coliseum BART station to claim your ticket.

This limited time promotion is only available for the Coliseum site until further notice. The fare value is enough to get home to any station in the BART system, except for SFO station.

Muni

Beginning Tuesday, February 23rd, SFMTA Muni and Paratransit will be providing free transportation for those traveling to and from their COVID-19 vaccinations. Please have your vaccine card or appointment confirmation with you if asked for proof for payment on Muni.

Paratransit van riders must call to make a trip reservation and indicate that they are going to receive their COVID-19 vaccine. Paratransit taxi riders will have \$60 loaded onto their taxi debit card, which will be valid for up to six months.

SFMTA will also be have \$60 in additional funds available for taxi service for those who use the <u>Essential Trip Card</u>.

These offers are only available for trips to <u>city-sponsored high-volume vaccination sites</u>.
