

## COVID-19 Vaccination Information

### *Updated April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021*

California is extending vaccine eligibility to all residents beginning Thursday, April 15<sup>th</sup>. However, [many local health departments](#) (including San Francisco) have already expanded vaccine eligibility. ### Special Transit Services to/from Vaccination Sites

#### BART

In February, BART implemented a free ride home program (valued at \$7) for those being vaccinated at the Oakland Coliseum site. Please show your vaccination card with a matching date to BART staff at the Coliseum BART station to claim your ticket.

This limited time promotion is only available for the Coliseum site until further notice. The fare value is enough to get home to any station in the BART system, except for SFO station.

#### Muni

In February, SFMTA Muni and Paratransit began providing free transportation for those traveling to and from their COVID-19 vaccinations. Please have your vaccine card or appointment confirmation with you if asked for proof for payment on Muni.

Paratransit van riders must call to make a trip reservation and indicate that they are going to receive their COVID-19 vaccine. Paratransit taxi riders will have \$60 loaded onto their taxi debit card, which will be valid for up to six months.

SFMTA will also have \$60 in additional funds available for taxi service for those who use the [Essential Trip Card](#).
