PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Each year, TMASF Connects provides printed materials for our property management members to use in the event of an emergency or power disruption. Due to the continued augmentation of transportation services related to COVID-19, this annual package will be postponed until later this year. As the state of California continues to reopen, TMASF Connects will continue monitoring the development of printed transit materials by local transportation agencies.

The information we are providing is a streamlined resource to be used when online services are unavailable. It is designed for easy printing and distribution as needed. It is intended to be a tool for property management to assist their staff and tenants. We encourage you to share this piece with your tenants and keep a couple of printed copies on hand.
