



SFUSD HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDE ON SCHOOLS REOPENING

The following information was taken from [SFUSD townhall meeting on August 3, 2021](#).

SFUSD, partnering with UCSF, San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH), and SF Department of Children, Youth and Families (DCYF), hosted a series of town halls to provide information on a safe return to schools for SFUSD families. The first day of instruction for the fall semester begins August 16, 2021. The [CDC](#) is recommending universal indoor masking for teachers, staff, students, and visitors, regardless of vaccination status, and SFUSD will continue to require that face masks be worn by both teachers and students.

SFUSD GUIDELINES

- **Starting September 7th, all [SFUSD employees](#) will be required to be fully vaccinated. Any employee that is not vaccinated yet will need to get a mandated COVID-19 test at least weekly.**
- SFDPH will review ventilation systems at all school buildings with a SF Health Officer approval prior to reopening
- Surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected daily
- Meals should be eaten outdoors as space and weathers permit, with masks worn in between bites and sips

FREE MUNI FOR YOUTH

Effective Sunday, August 15th, SFMTA is launching a pilot program that offers Free Muni for Youth that will extend to all youths 18 years of age and younger, regardless of household income. This program will start at the beginning of 2021 school year and will run through 2022 school year. No application or proof of payment/Clipper card will be required to ride Muni vehicles, but youths over the age of 16 are encouraged to carry an ID in case they are asked to provide a proof of age.
