

Outside Lands Festival + Halloween Weekend

Friday, October 29th- Sunday, October 31st, 2021

[Outside Lands Festival](#) will be taking place in Golden Gate Park at the Polo Field and Lindley Meadow on Friday, October 29th through Sunday, October 31st. The festival is 12:00 PM- 10:00 PM each day. Gates open at 11:00 AM.

Please note that the high volume of festival patrons may affect the morning and evening commute on Friday, October 29th. According to [SFMTA](#), 74,000 attendees are expected each day over the course of the weekend. Ridership may be higher than usual on SFMTA/Muni, BART, AC Transit, Golden Gate Transit, SF Bay Ferry, and Caltrain routes destined for San Francisco. Additionally, the Haight, Richmond, and Sunset districts may experience heavy traffic and congestion.

Transportation Overview

- All streets in Golden Gate Park west of Park Presidio and Crossover, and Sunset between Irving and Martin Luther King will be closed from Thursday, October 28th at 8:00 PM to Sunday, October 31st at 11:00 PM.
- Extra [SFMTA/Muni](#) service will be provided on 5R Fulton Rapid, N Judah, and 5X Fulton Express.
- [Shuttles](#) will pick up festival goers at the Bill Graham Civic Auditorium, which is close to Civic Center BART and Muni Station.
- Loading zones for ride-hail vehicles and charter buses will pick riders up from 30th Ave. & Balboa St. (North side) and Irving St. between 25th and 27th Aves. (South side).
- On Sunday, October 31st, [BART](#) will be offering extended service beyond 9 PM servicing all stops except for SFO and OAK airports.
