ON TRANSIT



Many transportation agencies continue to offer discounted fares in April and beyond to welcome commuters returning to the transit system. TMASF Connects has developed this resource sheet, gathering information on transportation agencies that are currently offering fare discounts. As a reminder, please note that TSA requires masks to be worn on all public transportation agencies until May 3rd (as of this writing).

CLIPPER

For a limited time, <u>Clipper</u> is voiding the \$3 Clipper card charge for commuters who set up a new Clipper card on their phones. The promotion does not include new plastic Clipper cards and will be automatically applied for new cards purchased and added to mobile devices (<u>iOS</u> or <u>Android</u>). <u>Click Here</u> for more information.

GOLDEN GATE TRANSIT

Golden Gate Transit has started service on a new pilot bus route – <u>Route 114</u>, which provides commute service to the San Francisco Financial District from Mill Valley and Marin City. Route 114 operates Monday – Friday.

CALTRAIN

Caltrain is offering 50% off all non-Go Pass Fares in the month of April. This includes the April Monthly Pass, Day Passes, One-Ways, Zone Upgrades, and is also eligible for youth and senior discounts. <u>Click Here</u> for more information.

Caltrain Monthly Passes will be offered at a <u>20% discount</u> through June 30, 2023. Benefits include unlimited trips between all zones on weekends and holidays and free or discounted transfers to SFMTA, Samtrans, VTA, and Dumbarton Express.

SFMTA/ MUNI The Free Muni Program will be available to all youth 18 years of age and under through August 14, 2022. All youth 18 years and under will be able to ride Muni regardless of financial status or verification, and without proof of payment. Cable Car access will still require the use of a valid pass (loaded onto a Clipper card). Click Here for more information.
