

Weekend Central Subway Service Begins Saturday, November 19th

Please be aware that this **Saturday, November 19th, Muni will begin special weekend-only service of the Central Subway**, servicing stops between Chinatown-Rose Pak Station and 4th and Brannan Streets. Trains will run every 12 minutes on Saturdays and Sundays from 8AM to 12AM and will stop along the way at Union Square/Market Street Station and Yerba Buena/Moscone Station. Customers can transfer underground from Powell Station to Union Square/Market Street Station to access the Central Subway from BART and Muni routes along the Market Street subway tunnel.

On January 7, new T-Third Metro service will begin from Sunnydale to Chinatown via the Central Subway, giving customers a direct connection from Bayview, Visitacion Valley and nearby neighborhoods to SoMa, Union Square and Chinatown. Service will run seven days a week, Monday through Friday from 6AM to 12AM, and Saturdays and Sundays from 8AM to 12AM. Trains will continue to provide service along 3rd and 4th Streets, but will no longer run along King Street, the Embarcadero or Market Street.
